The Middle East is changing constantly. Over the last five years, many states are experiencing major changes of their political, economic, social and cultural fabric. In some cases, this was caused by popular unrest; in others, by top-down reforms. These changes also influenced the current EU – Middle East Relations. This program will provide an overview of the major dimensions of EU foreign policy towards the Middle East. Furthermore, it will discuss the relative strengths and weaknesses of the different policies of the EU – with special emphasis on the policies towards the Middle East. The program will also offer discussions with experts about German-Iranian and European-Iranian relations. Last but not least, the invited professors, tutors and students will take up the question where EU – Middle East Relations might be heading.
